Notice to All Residents

New Parking Decals and Procedures

April / May 2010

Effective May 01, 2010, new parking decals will be required to be displayed on all vehicles. The new decals must be displayed on the bottom left hand corner of the driver's side windshield.

Starting April 16, 2010, all none-owner residents must register their vehicles with Ruben Morales, Cotton Hope's Code Enforcer. None-owner residents must contact Ruben at 683-0825 to arrange for an appointment or you may stop by Ruben's apartment, 1911, between the hours of 6:00PM and 9:00PM Monday –Saturday from April 16th to April 30, 2010.

A \$10.00 Registration Fee will be required to obtain a new parking decal.

None-owner residents must provide the following:

- 1. A copy of your current, valid lease.
- 2. A copy of your Driver's License.
- 3. A copy of your Vehicle Registration.
- 4. Proof of Insurance
- 5. A \$10.00 Registration Fee. (Check or Money Order NO CASH)

Failure to acquire a new parking decal by May 01, 2010 may result in your vehicle being towed at owner's expense.

Cotton Hope owners may call Jack Hurst, Cotton Hope's Property Manager, to obtain information on the procedures to obtain the new parking decals.

VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION INFORMATION:

- 1. **PARKING STICKERS ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE:** If the vehicle is sold, the decal from that car must be removed and exchanged for a new decal issued by the on-site manager at no charge. If the old decal is not returned a \$25.00 charge will be levied for its replacement.
- **2. PARKING:** Each unit is allotted only one parking space underneath the buildings and this is on a "first come, first served" basis. Cars that are illegally parked, <u>doubled parked</u> or inoperable or abandoned are subject to being towed at owner's expense. Trucks larger then I ton are not permitted to park on the property. **All vehicles must have a valid parking decal or visitors pass.**
